RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions and safety regulations of Yachting Queensland, the measurements and rules of the classes competing, and the sailing instructions. Any yacht not complying with its class rules may incur a penalty to its yardstick.

INSURANCE: All entrants must submit proof of current Public Liability Insurance.

REGISTRATION: Entries on the attached form close with the Race Secretary on May 12, 2010. Nominations will also be accepted up to 12 noon on Saturday May 15. Boats are required to sign on to confirm correct nomination. Sail numbers entered on registration will only be changed with permission of the Race Committee. Failure to comply may result in disqualification. A minimum of 3 entries are required to create a division.

NOMINATION FEES: SENIORS \$25.00 JUNIORS \$10.00

SCORING SYSTEM: The Bonus Point scoring system Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing shall apply. All races shall score.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Will be available at the clubhouse after 10.00 a.m. on Saturday May 15, 2010. A competitors meeting will be held at the Clubhouse before the first race at 1200 hrs.

ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES: The 720 degree turns penalty Rule 44 of the Racing Rules will apply.

TROPHIES & PRIZES: Trophies shall be decided using VYC/YQ yardsticks. The Race Committee will decide the yardstick of any class not listed by the VYC and adjust any yardstick as deemed necessary.

Trophies will be awarded as follows: Up to 5 boats: first only. 6 to 8 boats: first & second. Over 9 Boats: first, second & third. Random prizes shall also be drawn at the presentation of trophies after the completion of racing. Crews must be present to receive random prizes.

SOCIAL: A social function will be held at the Clubhouse on Saturday night with meals available. Breakfast is available on the deck from 8.00 am Sunday and lunch is available both Saturday and Sunday. Accommodation can be arranged if required.
